

POLICIES ON SELECTION OF STUDENT

Admission is open to all students and be retained if they meet the following:

Students with a weighted grade average of 75% or higher are qualified for retention in the following semester.

- . Lorma Colleges adopts the following academic retention policies in the Computer Technology Department Students are considered out in the department if they:
 - Failed in their repeated subjects
 - Failed 50% of the total unit load
- . A student who has a grade of incomplete is given at least 2 weeks after the final examination to complete it.
- . A student who has dropped in all subjects with a valid reason may be admitted to enroll on a probation status for one semester.
 - **PHYSICAL EDUCATION**-All Physical Education subjects should be completed during the first two years in College
 - **BIBLE SUBJECTS and NSTP**- All Bible subjects required in the curriculum must be taken during the first two years in college like P.E. and first year in college like National Service Training Program (NSTP) subjects.
 - **Science and Technology Course Curriculum**- The Science and Technology Institute follows the curriculum prescribed by the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) for the courses being offered:THREE-Year Biomedical Equipment Technology, TWO-Year Computer Technology with Specialization in Computer Programming, TWO-Year Computer Technology with Specialization in Computer Secretarial, TWO-Year Computer Technology with Specialization in Computer Technician and new Window-based short-term EDP courses.
